The Suffolk County Council plans to take a contingent of four Troops, consisting of 36 youth and 4 adult leaders in each troop, to the 2010 National Scout Jamboree which will be held at Fort A.P. Hill in Caroline County, Virginia, July 26 to August 4, 2010.

To attend as a leader, an adult must meet the following qualifications:

- Meet the qualifications for one of the positions.
- Agree to abide by the commitment and code of conduct.
- Be approved by the council jamboree committee.
- Participate in pre-jamboree training experience
- Submit a Jamboree Medical Form

The cost of the trip is \$1495.00 and will include transportation, meals, lodging, special patches, hat, T-shirt, all Patrol and Troop equipment, a training weekend and a touring adventure on the way to the Jamboree. We leave Long Island on Saturday, July 24. Final payment will be due in February of 2010. Interviews will take place in the fall of 2008.

Scoutmaster:

- Have served as Scoutmaster for at least one year during the three-year period prior to July 1, 2010.
- Completed basic **New Leader Essentials, Scoutmaster Specific and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.**
- Be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness.
- Have participated in the pre-jamboree training experience.
- Have filed a National Scout Jamboree Personal health & Medical Record, Class 3, before pre-jamboree training with the Council Jamboree Committee.
- Complete **Youth Protection Training.**
- Be approved by the local council.
- Be flexible and a team player.
- Although not required, **Wood Badge** and/or **Scouter's Key** are desirable qualifications.

First Assistant Scoutmaster:

- Same Qualifications as Scoutmaster.

Second Assistant Scoutmaster:

- Be at least 21 years of age by July 1, 2010.
- Have served actively in an adult troop leadership position for at least one year during the three year period prior to July 1, 2010.
- Have participated in the pre-jamboree training experience.
- Complete **Youth Protection Training.**
- Be approved by the local council.
- Be flexible and a team player.
- Although not required, **Wood Badge** and/or **Scouter's Key** are desirable qualifications.

Third Assistant Scoutmaster:

- Be at least 18 -21 years of age by July 1, 2010.
- Have served actively in a troop leadership position.
- Have participated in the pre-jamboree training experience.
- Have filed a National Scout Jamboree Personal health & Medical Record, Class 3, before a pre-jamboree training with the Council Jamboree Committee.
- Complete **Youth Protection Training.**
- Be approved by the local council.
- Be flexible and a team player.
- Although not required, **Wood Badge** and/or **Scouter's Key** are desirable qualifications.
