## The Unit Leader's Role

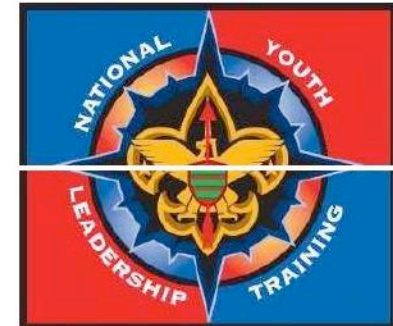
The Unit Leader's role is critical to the success of the youth unit leader in implementing the unit's goals. The Unit Leader must approve the youth's application.

## How is the course set up?

The patrol method is used extensively throughout the training. Teams are on their own to set up campsites, cook some meals and carry out other activities without direct adult supervision. A Team Guide is assigned to each patrol to advise and be a resource to the participants throughout the learning process. The team/course setting provides an opportunity for participants to practice the newly learned skills providing the home unit with improved effectiveness and enthusiasm from the youth leaders. Team instructors will help guide this learning. The training guidelines and rules are the same for those found in the Scout Oath and Law, Venturing Oath and Code, the Outdoor Code, and other national and council practices and procedures.

This Leadership Program is for boys 13 and older who are members of a Boy Scout Troop and for young men and women who are members of a Venturing Crew.





## What is NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING?

NYLT is a week- long outdoor experience for current and future troop and crew leaders, utilizing the patrol method. It presents leadership skills in multiple formats

providing the opportunity for participants to live and practice these leadership skills. Virtually all of the training is conducted by the youth staff. The course follows the National BSA *National Youth Leadership Training* Curriculum.

Course runs 2 weekends, Friday night through Sunday morning.



## Who can attend?

NYLT is for you if you're a Boy Scout who can answer YES to All of the following:

- ◆ You'll be 13 years old by March 23, 2012;
- ◆ You will not be 18 years old before April 1, 2012;
- ◆ You'll be at least a first class Scout by March 23, 2012;
- ◆ You now hold or intend to hold a unit leadership position;
- ◆ You are mature enough and responsible enough to spend 2 weekends camping with youth you've never met, with minimal adult supervision, and always live the Scout oath and law;
- ◆ You agree to practice the skills you learn at NYLT when you return to your home unit; AND
- ◆ Your parents and Unit Leader agree and recommend you.

NYLT is for you if you're in Venturing and can answer YES to All of the following:

- ◆ You will not be 21 years old before April 1, 2012?
- ◆ You have completed either crew officer training or Venturing Leadership Skills Course or Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews
- ◆ You are mature enough and responsible enough to spend 2 weekends camping\*\* with others you've never met, with minimal adult supervision, and always live the Venturing oath and **code**;
- ◆ You agree to practice the skills you learn at NYLT when you return to your home unit; AND
- ◆ Your parents and Unit Leader agree and recommend you.

\*\* Course leaders will work with you in advance if you do not have extensive camping experience.
