Hours: Monday & Thursday: 9 AM – 8 PM, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday & Saturday: 9 AM – 6 PM, Sunday: 11 AM – 5 PM
Instructions: Go to the cash register and ask for Scouting for Food bags.
