

Matinecock District Summer Merit Badge Program 2019

The merit badge classes will be held at:

St. Hugh of Lincoln

Huntington Station, NY

Two sessions are scheduled each with two evening classes (6:30 to 9:00 pm)

Session 1 will meet **Thursday July 11th and July 18th**

Session 2 will meet **Thursday Aug 1st and Aug 8th**

Scouts must attend both classes in the same session,

Uniform is required.

Pre-registration is required. “No Walk-ins “

You **must** arrive with a Merit Badge Book, a Blue Card signed by your Scoutmaster, pencils, paper and any materials required for the merit badge. A merit badge work book will be very helpful. **There is no fee but we are requesting a non-perishable food donation for the Church.** Your parent / guardian must sign you in and out of every session day.

Please register for the July session no later than July 3rd and the August session by July 25th. Each scout will be personally notified of his registration acceptance into the merit badge class by email. Please note space in some merit badge classes will be limited by size of class and age/rank of scout. Sign up early. 2nd Session “AUGUST”: ”: Citizenship in the World, Electricity, Indian Lore, Law, Public Health, Public Speaking, Safety

Cit in the World	Priority will be given to older scouts (13+) and Star and Life ranks.
Safety	Read & bring MB Book and MB worksheet from Class size limited to 6 Scouts.
Public Speaking	Class is limited to 6 Scouts.
Digital Tech	Proof of Cyber chip completion.
Music	Bring your instrument.
