What time does Day Camp run?

Day Camp is Monday through Friday from 8:30 - 4:00. Drop off and Pick up for Day Camp will take place in our upper parking lot.

Is there Before and After Care?

Yes. Campers can be dropped off as early as 8:00 and can be picked up as late as 5:00. Please let us know if you need to take advantage of this service. There is no additional fee.

Who can attend?

Boy Scout Day Camp is intended for Scouts who just bridged over from Webelos or those who are brand new to the Scouting program.

What is the cost?

A week of Boy Scout Day Camp is \$295 if paid in full before May 1st. The fee May 1st and after is \$320 per week.

What do I need to bring?

Scouts should wear clothing appropriate for the daily weather. Scouts should come to camp WEARING a bathing suit so we can spend time at the waterfront. Socks and shoes must be worn at all times. NO SANDALS. A backpack with water bottle, towel and water shoes is suggested.

Can you tell me about the meals?

Lunch is provided daily.

I have a Scout with special Dietary needs. How is that handled?

We make every effort to meet the special dietary needs/restrictions for our guests. If possible, please notify us one week in advance in case special items need to be purchased.

How many Merit Badges will my son earn this week?

Scouts will have an opportunity to work on one merit badge and other rank advancement. Every scout earns merit badges at their own pace based on skill, difficulty and their commitment to completing what they have started. A successful week at camp is one where the Scout has fun, makes new friends and learns something new!

Are Cell Phones and Electronic Devices permitted at camp?

Baiting Hollow Scout Camp does not have any restrictions on electronic devices. Baiting Hollow Scout Camp is not responsible for loss or damage to your personal electronic devices.

Do the Scouts need spending money?

Baiting Hollow Scout camp has a trading post where you can purchase souvenirs, some basic necessities, and snacks/candy. Merit Badge books are also for sale in the trading post along with items that may be needed to complete merit badges. A commemorative t-shirt will be available for purchase along with other items in our Trading Post.

Is a Medical/Health form required?

Yes. A link to the correct BSA Annual Health & Medical Record form for each program is in the email confirmation materials that are sent upon online registration. This program does not require a doctor's signature. The form can be filled out by the parent or legal guardian.

Can I use the Medical Form from last year?

If the physical examination documented on last year's form is less than one year from the day your camp program starts, then you may use it. If not, a new form documenting a more recent physical examination is needed.

Do I get the medical form back?

No. We are required to keep them. Please do not turn in originals. We can accept photocopies.
